

BOT AWARDED CONTRACT FOR WILLIAM HALTON PARKWAY EXTENSION IN OAKVILLE

Oakville, February 2, 2021 - Bot Engineering & Construction Ltd. (Bot) is pleased to announce that it has been awarded the contract for the William Halton Parkway Extension in Oakville by the Region of Halton. Spanning the Sixteen Mile Creek, the project connects Third Line to Neyagawa Blvd.

Steve Bot, Vice President and General Manager of Bot said, "We are very excited to receive this award and are pleased to be building this important and exciting infrastructure project for Oakville and the Halton Region. The scope of this expansion project and the major structures component fit perfectly with our company's expertise."

This \$80M contract is being delivered using the bid-build procurement model. The expansion of the William Halton Parkway will serve as an enhanced east-west route in Oakville, reducing traffic congestion on the current Highway 5 (Dundas Street) corridor. The contract includes a new four-kilometre, four lane extension of the William Halton Parkway from Third Line to Neyagawa Blvd with two roundabouts. The roundabouts are located at Burnhamthorpe Road and Fourth Line. In addition to the lane extensions and roundabouts, two new bridges will be built over the Sixteen Mile Creek, utilizing unique cast-in-place segmental construction techniques.

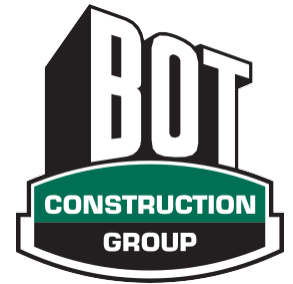
